

SVAMITVA SCHEME - NATIONAL CONFERENCE
15-16 April 2021

A two days National Conference on SVAMITVA Scheme was held virtually on 15th and 16th April 2021

On 16th April 2021, Hon'ble Minister of Panchayati Raj Shri Narendra Singh Tomar addressed the Principal Secretaries/Chief Secretaries of Revenue Department along with State Panchayat Raj Departments to share the experiences of Pilot phase and to lay down the road map for next phase of the scheme. Conference provided a platform for stakeholders to share the learnings and experience gained in the implementation process of the scheme so far and to facilitate cross learning platform for new states.

Participants and contributors in the conference were from Ministry of Panchayati Raj, State Department of Panchayat Raj, State Department of Revenue, Survey of India, Ministry of Civil Aviation, Department of Land Resources, Department of Science and Technology, Department of Financial Services, NITI Aayog, NABARD, NRSC, NIC, GIS Domain Experts and other industry experts. In the conference, there were extensive discussion regarding land governance of Abadi areas; Development of Drone-Ecosystem in India & CORS network; leveraging spatial data for better planning and; Monetisation of property cards.
